

# **PUBLIC NOTICE OF TRANSIT SERVICE CHANGES**

## **AMADOR TRANSIT SERVICE CHANGES EFFECTIVE 8/3/2026**

Amador Transit (AT) announces the implementation of transit service changes effective **8/3/2026**. These changes are necessary to address budget constraints and ensure the long-term sustainability of public transportation services throughout Amador County.

As part of the Fiscal Year 2026–2027 budget process, AT staff worked with the AT Board of Directors Finance Committee to evaluate service levels, available funding, and operating revenues. A comprehensive route-by-route analysis was conducted to identify services with the lowest ridership and the least overall impact on the community.

Effective **8/3/2026**, the following service changes will be implemented:

### **Plymouth Routes**

Both Plymouth fixed routes will be discontinued. Approximately 95% of existing ridership on these routes can continue to be accommodated through Amador Transit's Dial-A-Ride service, which provides direct-trip transportation for eligible riders.

### **6-6 Shuttle Route**

The 6-6 Shuttle route will be discontinued. While this route represents the final shuttle service of the day, it consistently experiences the lowest ridership in the transit system, averaging approximately one to two passengers per day.

### **Upcountry Routes**

All four Upcountry routes will be modified to designate Sugar Pine Loop as the furthest destination served. Service will no longer continue to Amador Station. This adjustment reduces approximately 12 miles from each route while maintaining service to the majority of existing riders.

These adjustments are necessary to align transit services with available funding while preserving essential transportation options for residents throughout Amador County.
